It tells the story of Edward, a beautiful but vain china rabbit who belongs to a little girl named Abilene. Though deeply loved, Edward cares only about himself. One day, he is accidentally lost at sea, beginning a long and transformative journey.

Along the way, Edward passes through the hands of many different people — a fisherman and his wife, a homeless man and his dog, a sick child, and others. Through these experiences, he learns about love, loss, compassion, and what it truly means to care for others.

By the end of his journey, Edward has changed completely: he understands the importance of love and connection, even after heartbreak. This will lead very nicely into our essential question: "Why might someone's most important journey be one we can't see?"

For our whole-class guided read, we will continue with the book Wonder, as the children really seemed to enjoy it!
