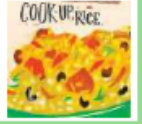




From Plate to Page

MUSIC

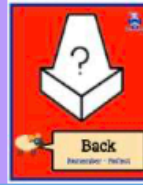
- Creating short rhythmic phrases and patterns.

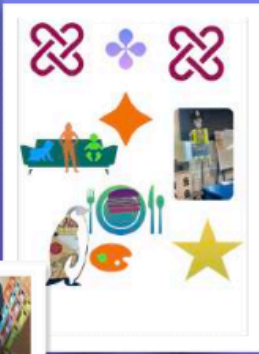
